## 1. Project Summary

The project aims to foster academic excellence and promote cross-cultural exchange among faculty members from the University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) Cyprus and two partnering higher education institutions. Through a comprehensive blended intensive programme, participants will engage in online workshops covering essential topics such as Inclusive Andragogy in Higher Education, Curriculum Development and Assessment, Academic Integrity in Higher Education, and AI in Education. Following the online component, face-to-face workshops will take place in Cyprus, focusing on Cultural Exchange and Understanding, Challenges in Higher Education Today, Teaching Critical Thinking Skills, LinguaFiesta, and Collaborative Learning. Additionally, participants will have the opportunity to explore various cultural sites during their time in Cyprus, including the tour of the village of Pyla, renowned for its unique atmosphere of peaceful coexistence between Greek and Turkish Cypriots. They will also visit St. Lazarus Church and the Medieval Castle in Larnaca, the village of Lefkara, Ayia Napa, Protaras, Hala Sultan Tekke, and Larnaca Salt Lake. These workshops and activities are designed to deepen cultural understanding, employ inclusive teaching methodologies, nurture critical thinking skills, and provide language enrichment opportunities. The programme will culminate in a vibrant Cultural Fusion Party, providing a celebratory conclusion to the enriching experience. This initiative aims to engage a minimum of 15 participants from each of the collaborating institutions, ensuring a robust and diverse exchange of knowledge and perspectives.

## 2. Objectives

1. Enhance participants' understanding of academic integrity and its importance in higher education.
2. Explore the applications and ethical considerations of AI in education.
3. Develop participants' skills in curriculum development, assessment, and addressing challenges in higher education.
4. Promote cultural exchange and understanding among participants.
5. Cultivate participants' ability to design and implement instructional strategies that effectively foster critical thinking skills among students across various disciplines.
6. Equip participants with inclusive teaching strategies for diverse learners.

7. Facilitate language learning and appreciation of Greek and partner universities' cultures.

### 3. Methods

The project will employ a blended approach, integrating both online and face-to-face activities to achieve its objectives. Initially, online workshops will be conducted covering diverse topics such as academic integrity, AI in education, curriculum development, and challenges in higher education. These sessions will utilise a combination of presentations, case studies, group discussions, and hands-on activities to engage participants effectively.

Following the online component, face-to-face workshops will take place in Cyprus, focusing on fostering cultural exchange and understanding, inclusive andragogy, and language learning. These sessions will incorporate interactive presentations, small group discussions, cultural exhibits, and practical activities to immerse participants in diverse cultural experiences. Additionally, language workshops will provide participants with opportunities to learn basic conversational skills in Greek and the languages of the participants from the partner institutions.

The programme will culminate in the Cultural Fusion Party, where participants will celebrate Greek and partner cultures through live performances, culinary delights, language exchange sessions, and cultural booths. Throughout the project, a minimum of 15 participants from each institution will be accommodated, ensuring a diverse and inclusive cohort.

The methods employed in this project are designed to facilitate active learning, cross-cultural interactions, and the acquisition of both knowledge and practical skills. By combining online and face-to-face modalities, the programme aims to provide a comprehensive and immersive experience that promotes academic excellence and cultural exchange among participants.

### 4. Outcomes

1. Increased awareness and understanding of academic integrity issues.

2. Enhanced integration of AI tools in teaching practices.
3. Improved skills in curriculum development and assessment.
4. Enhanced capacity to design and implement instructional activities that promote students' critical thinking abilities, leading to deeper engagement with course content and improved problem-solving skills.
5. Strengthened resilience and innovation in addressing challenges in higher education.
6. Enhanced cultural understanding and appreciation among participants.
7. Improved ability to create inclusive learning environments.
